CONTEST INFORMATION

WHO: Children in grades K-5 who either live in Aurora or go to school in Aurora are eligible. Artwork will be judged on content, creativity and printability. There will be one award.

WHAT: Create a drawing, painting or mixed media in black and white ONLY. Preferably a black marker such as a Sharpie fine point.

ARTWORK SIZE: All artwork must fit on a single 8 1/2" by 11" sheet of white paper. Keep your entry flat and unfolded.

ENTRY FORM: The entry form must be completed and attached to the back of your artwork. Only one entry per student.

HOW TO SUBMIT: Students must submit their artwork to their school home room teacher no later than October 30. The completed entry form (below) must be attached to the back of your artwork.

TEACHER INSTRUCTIONS: Teachers that participate in this program may submit one entry per child, depicting the goals/dreams or a portrait of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Teachers may mail (postmarked by November 8 2013) or hand delivered entries Officer Scott Newhouse, City of Aurora, 15151 E. Alameda Parkway, Aurora, CO 80015 no later than **Friday, November 8, 2013. NOTE:** Teachers must send an entry form home to the parents of their winning entries to secure a Parent Signature approving their child's participation in the contest and allowing their child's artwork to be used for the City of Aurora, 27th Annual MLK Jr. Commemoration campaign.

ARTWORK JUDGING: Final judging will be done by the MLK, Jr. Commemorative committee. Artwork will be judged according to the following criteria:

- Follows all contest rules.
- Clearly illustrates the goals/dreams or a portrait of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.
- · Shows creativity
- Shows quality of production (black and white only, no folds on the paper).
- Artwork must be able to be photographed for the City of Aurora, 27th Annual MLK Jr. Commemoration campaign and will used in flyer, posters, advertisements and t-shirt.
- Use plain white paper & artwork only one side 8 ½" by 11".
- All submissions will be retained and could be used in the Commemorative campaign for 2014.

WINNING ENTRIES: The winner will be notified by the middle of November. The winning entry will receive a copies of artwork used in the campaign, a t-shirt, art supplies.
